

Tylenol/Motrin Policy



The Trike Stop will not give any infant Tylenol or Motrin without a doctor's note stating that the child's fever is not a result of a contagious illness. Parents may not give their infant Tylenol before bringing them to care as it often masks contagious symptoms until it wears off, thus infecting the other children and staff. Children will not be allowed in care until after the medication has worn off (4-6 hours after consumption).

- If pain or fever is due to suspected teething please supply a doctor note stating they have been seen and are not contagious.
