Potty Training Policy



It is our philosophy that a child is ready to begin potty training when he or she is interested in using the toilet. When they are truly ready, potty training is very easy. Our mission at The Trike Stop is to make going to the bathroom as comfortable as possible. This means that we will never force a child to go to the bathroom.

When your child joins the 2's classroom they will be given the opportunity several times a day to use the toilet, walk into the bathroom or just go near the bathroom. This helps them get used to the toilet; it helps toilet time become a normal part of their daily routine and provides them the opportunity to use the toilet when they are ready instead of when we think they are.

Once your child is ready to wear underwear please talk with their teacher to ensure communication. Please bring in several changes of clothing (including shoes!). Although we understand that accidents are a natural occurrence during the learning process, due to sanitary reasons we cannot accommodate several accidents a day. If your child has too many accidents too regularly this is a sign your child is not ready to be in underwear and you may be asked to go back to diapers and try again later on.
